Covid-19 Agreement

To minimise the risk of transmission between workmates and staff whilst at Meadow Barn View (MBV), there will be procedures in place which must be adhered to. If a workmate is unable to adhere to a particular procedure, a separate risk assessment will be completed on an individual basis.

Workmate/Parent/Carer agrees that;

1. Workmate will be dropped off and collected at precisely the given time. These staggered times are to reduce the number of people around at the same time.
2. Workmates will have their temperature taken on arrival using a non-contact thermometer. If their temperature is above 37 degrees, they will be unable to stay and will be asked to leave with their parent/carer.
3. Suncream will be applied prior to arrival at MBV – staff will not be applying cream.
4. Workmates will bring their own packed lunch, snacks and drinks for the day which will be in a cool bag. This will remain with them at their work station throughout the day.
5. As usual, workmates will be required to bring all necessary kit for the day eg a sun hat, wellies etc in a bag.
6. If workmates become unwell or display symptoms of Covid-19 whilst not at MBV, MBV will be notified ASAP and workmate WILL NOT come to MBV. In this scenario, a workmate will need to follow government guidelines regarding being tested and following appropriate advice if there is a positive result.
7. If a workmate becomes unwell with symptoms of Covid-19 whilst at MBV, they will be isolated and cared for by staff wearing PPE until arrangements can be made for their collection. A test should then be arranged and they should follow relevant government guidelines if the result is positive.
8. If staff suspect a workmate may be displaying symptoms associated with Covid-19, the workmate's temperature will be taken using a forehead thermometer. This may be repeated through the day as required and equipment will be thoroughly cleaned.
9. Workmates will be assigned a toilet to use whilst on site. This will be cleaned between uses. There will be further guidance given to workmates around using the toilet and handwashing.
10. Workmates will be prompted to wash their hands and use hand sanitiser gel thoroughly and regularly.
11. Workmates will be asked, and reminded, to remain 2 metres apart from staff and other workmates at all times.

12. Workmates who use taxis to travel to MBV will be required to change their clothes on arrival.
